NO-ANCHOR ZONE
Anchoring is prohibited in the park except in designated anchorages at Francis Bay, Lind Point, and Cruz Bay. No overnight anchoring is allowed in Cruz Bay. No anchoring is allowed in the monument. Over 200 mooring buoys have been installed in the bays around St. John.
